VOLUNTEER CHARTER

After Paris 2024, there will be Paris 2025 for badminton with the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships.
The French Badminton Federation (FFBaD) has the honour of organising this major world badminton event.
This charter sets out the commitments of the volunteer and the Organising Committee during the event.

ARTICLE 1 : DEFINITION

The volunteer is a member of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships 2025 organisation. He/she undertakes freely and without remuneration to carry out the predefined tasks that he/she accepts.

ARTICLE 2 : COMMITMENTS OF THE EVENT ORGANISING COMMITTEE

The Organising Committee of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships undertakes to:

- Welcoming and considering the volunteer as an employee in his or her own right;
- Provide a specific person to manage all the volunteers, who will be available to listen to and respond to questions and requests;
- Provide the volunteer with a schedule indicating the time slots for assignments and rest periods depending on the assignment;
- Organise, in conjunction with the organisation's managers (heads of sector), the training the volunteer needs to carry out his or her assignment successfully;
- Give the volunteer a welcome pack on the first day;
- Pay for the volunteer's meals in accordance with the terms and conditions defined by the Organising Committee of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships;
- Take out third-party liability and personal accident insurance for the volunteer, for the duration of the assignment, to cover any damage caused to a third party and/or suffered by the volunteer;
- To ensure the health and safety of the volunteer during the assignment;
- Organise moments of sharing and exchange between the different teams and the organisation, all in a friendly atmosphere.

ARTICLE 3 : VOLUNTEER COMMITMENT

The volunteer undertakes to:

- Carry out the mission(s) entrusted to him/her with diligence, seriousness, loyalty and discretion;
- Respect the organisation and operation of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships Organising Committee;
- Not resell the invitations and/or products distributed to them;
- Cooperate in a spirit of mutual understanding with the other members of the organisation;
- Respect the timetable given by the person in charge of the sector to which they are assigned;
- Inform the person in charge of volunteers in the event of withdrawal before or during the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships;
- Wear the official competition uniform when on duty;
- Not to resell in any way whatsoever any clothing donated. .

ARTICLE 4 : IMAGE RIGHTS

ARTICLE 5 : SECURITY

The volunteer undertakes to respect the rules of safety, hygiene and the instructions of the Organising Committee in the places where he/she will be working. In particular, he/she will ensure that no dangerous objects or products are brought into the venue.

ARTICLE 6 : CORPORATE SOCIAL RESPONSABILITY

The FFBaD is committed to a sustainable development approach, which is why the Organising Committee of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships is working to build a sustainable event and wishes to limit the environmental impact (greenhouse effect, waste production, etc.) of the competition as much as possible while strengthening its social dimension.

The Organising Committee undertakes to provide volunteers with the information they need, particularly through internal communications and general training, to adopt environmentally-friendly behaviour and to enable volunteers to inform and guide the public (spectators, media, partners, delegations, service providers, etc.) as effectively as possible towards eco-responsible behaviour.

The volunteer undertakes to adopt these behaviours (communicated through documents sent elsewhere) and to share them as part of the organisation of the competition.

ARTICLE 7 : LABEL « TERRAIN D'EGALITE »

The FFBaD, through the 'Terrain d'égalité' label awarded by the Délégation Interministérielle aux Grands Evénements Sportifs (DIGES) (Interministerial Delegation for Major Sports Events), is also committed to promoting gender equality, preventing and combating discrimination and Sexist and Sexual Violence (SGBV). As such, the Organising Committee of the TotalEnergies BWF Badminton World Championships is doing its utmost to build an egalitarian event and a healthy environment for all these populations.

It undertakes to provide volunteers with the necessary information and to implement all the appropriate measures required by the Label, in particular via internal communications and the media made available. The same commitment will be made to all those attending the event (media, partners, delegations, spectators, etc.).

Volunteers, for their part, undertake to respect and adopt the codes of good conduct set out in the materials and to follow the awareness-raising and training courses offered by the organising committee as part of the « Terrain d'Égalité » label.
